For the past year, The AT3 Center has partnered with Oklahoma ABLE Tech to provide self-paced courses on digital accessibility. These have been hosted in a course catalog specifically for The AT3 Center. However, Oklahoma ABLE Tech is also releasing versions of these courses in its own catalog. As a team, we've come together to determine that consolidating efforts into one catalog will allow Oklahoma ABLE Tech to release courses faster and thus get information to who needs it sooner.

What does this mean for you?

- Beginning September 1, you will no longer be able to access the AT3 Course Catalog.
 Instead, you will navigate to the Oklahoma ABLE Tech catalog via okabletech.org/courses to take the self-paced courses.
- All courses will be moved over to the Oklahoma ABLE Tech course catalog starting September 1.

In addition, the digital badges were not being accepted by most people who earned them, so Oklahoma ABLE Tech will also be removing the Credly digital badges from all courses. If you have completed the courses already, do not worry. Oklahoma ABLE Tech will be sending printable course certificates to anyone who has already completed the courses.
